**Pledge of Allegiance**

Beautification Vice-Chairwoman Diane Ciano led the Beautification Committee Members in the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Acceptance of Minutes**

A motion was made by Beautification Committee Member Pamela Wilson, seconded by Beautification Committee Member Barbara Huber, to accept the December 9, 2020 minutes. This motion was approved unanimously.

**New Business**

**a. Discuss Christmas tree removal and decorations**

Beautification Committee Vice-Chairwoman Diane Ciano and Beautification Committee Member Jerry Milne removed all of the Christmas decorations, The Terryville Fire Department took down the garland and bows. Everything is put away in containers. Beautification Committee Member Pamela Wilson is going to take down the small Christmas decorations on the topiaries. She will remove the topiaries and look into painting the snowman and fixing the hat.

The Committee wants to meet with the Mayor and an electrician about the lights that are not working in town near Baldwin Park and the Waterwheel.

Beautification Committee Member Mary Semon will write up a ticket about the issue with the photosensor outlets/lamp posts.

A discussion took place about buying 7 more garlands.

*A motion was made by Beautification Committee Member Barbara Huber, seconded by Beautification Committee Member Pamela Wilson to order 7 garlands and 7 red bows from All American Christmas Co. in the amount of \$1000.00 to be taken out of the grant line item. This motion was approved unanimously.*

**b. Discuss purchasing a tree to be planted**

Beautification Committee Member Jerry Milne suggested planting a tree at Baldwin Park in memory of everyone that died from COVID-19 – a sour wood. Will plant end of April early May. He will reach out to Ann Baldwin for permission.

*A motion was made by Beautification Committee Jean McMahon, seconded by Beautification Committee Member Barbara Huber to purchase a tree which will be planted at Baldwin Park in the amount of \$200.00. This motion was approved unanimously.*

A discussion took place about planting near the Waterwheel. This will be discussed more at the next meeting.

The water spigot at Baldwin Park will be discussed at the next meeting. Beautification Committee Vice-Chairwoman Diane Ciano will reach out to the Mayor about this.
