ORDINANCE NO. 14-09

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF OCEAN CITY PERTAINING TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF BULKHEADS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Ocean City, County of Cape May, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1

CHAPTER XXII, CONSTRUCTION OF NON-OCEANFRONT BULKHEADS, is hereby revised to read as follows:

Title: CONSTRUCTION OF NON-OCEANFRONT BULKHEADS

22-1 PURPOSE.

The City of Ocean City desires to create uniform regulations for the construction, reconstruction, repair or renovation of existing or new bulkheads within the City of Ocean City along the non-oceanfront any waterway or beach of Ocean City (Bayfront and Inlet). (Ord. #98-22, § 1)

22-2 PERMIT REQUIRED.

A permit shall be required before beginning the construction, reconstruction, repair or renovation of any bulkhead on any non-oceanfront waterway or beach within the City of Ocean City. Applications for a bulkhead permit shall be submitted to the Bulkhead Inspector who shall be appointed by the Mayor. The fee for said permit shall be one hundred (\$100.00) dollars and thereafter set annually by ordinance in accordance with Chapter XXX of this ordinance. (Ord. #98-22, § 1)

22-3 PERMIT APPLICATION.

All applications shall be on the form provided by the City and accompanied by plans showing the size, shape, configuration and location of such bulkheads, the specifications of material to be used in construction, reconstruction, renovation or repair, the manner in which materials shall be incorporated into the bulkhead and the fee for review. Bulkhead plans and specifications must be designed by an engineer licensed to practice in the State of New Jersey and signed and sealed by such engineer. The plan must contain the label "issued for construction pending a permit approval." (Ord. #98-22, § 1)

22-4 PERMIT APPROVALS.

The Bulkhead Inspector shall review the plans and grant or deny the application within twenty (20) business days upon receipt of a completed application. The review by the Bulkhead Inspector shall be in conformity with this Chapter, consistent with the minimum specifications and performance standards contained herein. For bulkhead repairs valued at less than one thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars, the requirements for meeting minimum specifications and performance standards, including the requirements for engineered plans, shall be waived by the Bulkhead Inspector. Following the effective date of this Chapter, singular or multiple repair projects affecting cumulatively less than twenty-five (25%) percent of the linear feet of a bulkhead sheeting on a single lot may be exempt from the standards as described in Section 22-8. The decision of the Bulkhead Inspector shall be binding and final unless the property owner appeals that decision to the Bulkhead Board of Appeals. (Ord. #98-22, § 1)

22-5 NOTIFICATION OF COMMENCEMENT OF CONSTRUCTION.

The Bulkhead Inspector shall receive notice of commencement of construction at least two (2) business days in advance of said construction. (Ord. #98-22, § 1)

22-6 FINAL INSPECTION.

Notice of project completion shall be given to the Bulkhead Inspector within seven (7) days of substantial completion of the project. The Bulkhead Inspector shall make a final inspection and receive a certification from a licensed engineer or land surveyor of the elevations of completed bulkhead height and adjacent water body soundings. (Ord. #98-22, § 1).

22-7 STATE AND FEDERAL APPROVALS.

Application for bulkhead work must be made to appropriate agencies of the State or Federal government including but not limited to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and the United States Army Corps of Engineers. No permit for work shall be issued until a valid

permit is received from appropriate State or Federal agencies having jurisdiction over the work. (Ord. #98-22, § 1).

22-8 MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS.

The minimum specifications for construction, reconstruction, repair or renovation of bulkheads are as follows:

- a. Bulkhead design shall provide for expected toe scour or proposed dredge depth and shall be shown on plans.
- b. Non-Oceanfront Bulkheads
 - 1. The minimum elevation of the top of the bulkhead or adjacent property grade shall be 7.0' NAVD, 1988 datum.
 - 2. Additional outfall piping is discouraged requires written approval from the City Engineer. If drainage conditions require piping, all new infrastructure must have an approved tide-control device.
 - 3. Existing privately-owned outfall piping will be extended and fitted with an approved tide-control device.
 - 4. Existing city-owned storm drains that penetrate private bulkheads shall be extended and maintained by the private property owner.
 - Bulkhead construction shall not adversely affect the depth of the adjacent water body.
- c. Oceanfront Bulkheads
 - The minimum elevation of the top of the bulkhead shall be 11.0' NAVD, 1988 datum.
 - The alignment shall be in accordance with a line designated as the "Official Oceanfront Bulkhead Line of Ocean City, N.J." shown on a drawing bearing this title and last revised October 12, 1971, including subsequent amendments or landward thereof.
 - 3. If the proposed construction methods shall require access and/or disturbance of City property, a detailed plan outlining the proposed limits of disturbance and proposed restoration shall be provided for approval by the City Engineer. City property shall be restored to a condition equal to preconstruction conditions.

22-9 PERFORMANCE STANDARDS.

All bulkheads construction, reconstruction, repair or renovation must meet the following performance standards in addition to the minimum standards set forth above. Applicants utilizing innovative methods of construction must be prepared to show how such methods will meet the performance standards.

- a. Bulkheads on non-oceanfront also function as flood protection. All bulkheads shall be designed to function as such.
- b. All bulkhead reconstruction shall utilize generally accepted engineering principles and practices.
- c. Materials selection must include evaluation of environmental impacts that are caused by the materials.
- Bulkhead construction shall not adversely affect adjacent properties. (Ord. #98-22, § 1)

22-10 UTILITIES.

It is the responsibility of the applicant to protect all existing utilities. The applicant is responsible for obtaining current "utility mark-out" for appropriate State or Local Agencies prior to commencement of construction. (Ord. #98-22, § 1)

22-11 MAINTENANCE, DUTY TO REPAIR.

All private non-oceanfront bulkheads within the City of Ocean City shall be maintained so they shall not pose a danger to the health, safety or welfare of the citizens of the City of Ocean City or to property within the City of Ocean City. The bulkheads shall be kept in a state of repair to prevent erosion or damage to abutting, adjacent or adjoining properties. Whenever a bulkhead has deteriorated to such a degree that it poses a danger to the property, or adjoining properties, the Bulkhead Inspector shall notify the property owner, in writing, of the nature of the deterioration and require the owner to make the necessary repairs. The property owner shall submit a plan of corrective action to the Bulkhead Inspector no later than thirty (30) days from receipt of the notice. Upon approval of the corrective action by the Bulkhead Inspector, the property owner shall complete all necessary repairs forthwith. If permits are required from the State of New Jersey or the Federal government, such permits shall be immediately applied for. In the event the property owner fails to submit a corrective action plan or fails to implement that plan, he shall be liable for the penalties and violations contained herein. (Ord. #98-22, § 1)

22-12 BULKHEAD BOARD OF APPEALS.

A Bulkhead Board of Appeals Committee shall be created and shall review appeals from the Bulkhead Inspector. The Board shall consist of the Director of Public Works Community Operations or his designee, the City Engineer, and a resident of the City of Ocean City appointed by the Mayor. Appeals shall be in writing on forms provided by the City. The Board

shall meet within twenty (20) business days of receipt of the appeal and shall issue its opinion within five (5) business days following a hearing on the appeal. The applicant shall be permitted to attend the appeal and produce evidence he thinks appropriate in support of the application. The appeal to the Board of Appeals shall be de novo. The Board of Appeals shall render its opinion based upon the conditions set forth in this Chapter including the minimum specifications and performance standards set forth below. The Board shall also consider, where appropriate, exceptional circumstances, hardship or other good cause of the applicant. (Ord. #98-22, § 1)

22-13 VIOLATION; PENALTIES.

Anyone violating any of the provisions of this Chapter shall be subject to a fine not to exceed the sum of one thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars and/or imprisonment not to exceed ninety (90) days for each violation. Each day of a continuing violation shall be a separate offense and shall be punishable as a separate offense. (Ord. #98-22, § 1)

Section 2

CHAPTER XXV, ZONING AND LAND DEVELOPMENT, Section 25-107, Definitions, is hereby revised to read as follows:

Shore protection structures installed by the developer on all properties bordering the Beach and Dune (BD) Zone facing the Atlantic Ocean shall be built in accordance with the Chapter XXI, "Flood Damage Prevention" Ordinance and Chapter XXII, "Construction of Bulkheads", and shall be in accordance with a line designated as the "Official Oceanfront Bulkhead Line of Ocean City, N.J." shown on a drawing bearing this title and dated October 12, 1971 last revised October 12, 1971, including subsequent amendments. (Ord. #02-19)

Section 3

CHAPTER XXV, ZONING AND LAND DEVELOPMENT Section 25-1700.6, Bulkheading, is hereby revised to read as follows:

25-1700.6.1 When Required.

All development on tidal lagoons, navigable waterways, or other bodies of water, either existing or proposed, shall provide for bulkheading. In no case shall bank slopes, bulkhead, riprap, revetments, or other elements of bank stabilization be located within required minimum yard areas.

25-1700.6.2 Construction Standards.

Bulkheads may be constructed of treated timber, reinforced concrete, marine alloy steel or other suitable material and a detailed design to be submitted by the developer in each case for review by the City Engineer, and approval by the United States Army Corps of Engineers and the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, as may be necessary. shall be constructed in accordance with Chapter XXI, "Flood Damage Prevention" and Chapter XXII (Construction of Bulkheads) of this ordinance.

25-1700.6.3 Waiver or Modification of Requirements.

The Planning Board may consider waiver and/or modification of this requirement when necessary to preserve wetlands or other natural features, provided that minimum lot sizes may be maintained and that all development may be reasonably secure from erosion.

Section 4

All ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent with this ordinance are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 5

If any portion of this ordinance is declared to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect the remaining portions of the ordinance which shall remain in full force and effect.

CITY OF OCEAN CITY ORDINANCE NO. 14-09 Master Plan Consistency Report

Introduction.

Ordinance 14-09 - "An ordinance amending and supplementing the Revised General Ordinances of the City of Ocean City Pertaining to the Construction Bulkheads," was introduced and adopted on first reading by City Council on March 14, 2014. According to the March 15, 2014 referral from the City Clerk, Ordinance 14-09 will be advertised according to law and is scheduled to have second reading and public hearing at the April 10, 2014 City Council meeting.

The "Municipal Land Use Law" provides the Planning Board with thirty-five (35) days from the referral date to prepare, review, adopt and transmit their consistency report regarding Ordinance 14-09 to City Council. NJS 40:55D-26 describes the Planning Board's responsibility regarding the master plan consistency review as follows:

"... the planning board shall make and transmit to the governing body, within 35 days after referral, a report including identification of any provisions in the proposed development regulation, revision or amendment which are inconsistent with the master plan and recommendations concerning those inconsistencies and any other matters as the board deems appropriate."

While formerly only zoning ordinances and amendments thereto were required to be submitted to the planning board, it is now clear from the wording in NIS 40:55D-26 that all "development regulations" must be referred to the planning board for comment and report. The statute requires that every zoning ordinance must "either be substantially consistent with the land use plan and housing plan of the master plan, or designed to effectuate such plan elements." The "Master Plan" referred to herein is the City of Ocean City Master Plan adopted February 3, 1988, and as subsequently amended by the Planning Board.

Ordinance Summary.

The existing regulations for bulkheads contained in Chapter XXII of the City Code were last revised in 1988, and pertain to bulkheads along the bay and lagoons. There are no specifications for oceanfront bulkheads. The existing ordinance references NGVD rather than the NAVD 1988 datum referenced on FEMA's updated flood elevation maps. The ordinance refers to the Director of Public Works, a position which was recently eliminated.

Ordinance 14-09 proposes revisions to Chapter XXII of the Revised General Ordinances as follows:

- ➤ It provides regulations and minimum specifications for all bulkheads including those on the bay, lagoons and beaches.
- ➤ It updates topographic datum reference to NAVD 1988.
- ➤ It replaces the Director of Public Works with the Director of Community Operations.

<u>Summary</u> – As noted above the Planning Board's responsibility in terms of the master plan consistency review is to identify any provisions in Ordinance 14-09 which are inconsistent with the Master Plan, and make recommendations concerning those inconsistencies and any other matters as the Board deems appropriate.

In defining "substantial consistency" the Supreme Court in Manalapan Realty v. Township Committee made it clear that some inconsistency is permitted "provided it does not substantially or materially undermine or distort the basic provisions and objectives of the Master Plan." The "Municipal Land Use Law" does not define the term inconsistent.

Ordinance 14-09 advances the following objectives from the Ocean City Master Plan:

- > To encourage municipal action which will guide the long range appropriate use and development of lands within the City of Ocean City in a manner which will promote the public health, safety, and general welfare of present and future residents.
- > To encourage the coordination of regulations and activities which influence development with a goal of producing efficient uses of land with appropriate development types and scale.

I have carefully reviewed and analyzed Ordinance 14-09 and the Master Plan. Based on this review and analysis, it is my professional opinion that Ordinance 14-09 is consistent with the Ocean City Master Plan.

Proposed Revisions to Bulkhead Ordinance

The existing ordinances regulating the construction of bulkheads in Ocean City pertain to bulkheads along the bay and lagoons. The datum referenced is NGVD, rather than the 1988 NAVD datum now being utilized on flood elevation maps. There are no specifications for oceanfront bulkheads. Finally, the ordinance currently refers to the Director of Public Works, a position which was eliminated in the most recent reorganization of the City departments.

This ordinance would provide minimum specifications for oceanfront bulkheads, change the pertinent datum to NAVD 1988, and change the reference from "Director of Public Works" to "Director of Community Operations."

ORDINANCE NO. 14-10

AN ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK PER (N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14) FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2014

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget to 0.5% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ocean City in the County of Cape May finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2014 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby determines that a 3.5% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$1,785,773.75 excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby determines that any amount authorized herein above that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Ocean City, in the County of Cape May, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2014 budget year, the final appropriations of the City of Ocean City shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by 3.5%, amounting to \$1,785,773.75, and that the CY 2014 municipal budget for the City of Ocean City be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.

This ordinance shall take effect in the time and manner prescribed by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 14-11

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER XXV, ZONING AND LAND DEVELOPMENT OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF OCEAN CITY MINOR SITE PLAN

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Ocean City, County of Cape May, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1

Article 1500 Development Applications Procedures and Plat Details of Chapter XXV "Zoning and Land Development" of the Revised General Ordinances of the City of Ocean City, New Jersey is hereby amended by adding the following new Section 25-1500.13 Minor Site Plans:

25-1500.13 Minor Site Plan.

25-1500.13.1 Required Documents.

Prior to issuance of a Certificate of Completeness or scheduling of a minor site plan for public hearing, the Administrative Officer (Planning Board or Board of Adjustment Secretary) shall determine that the following have been submitted in proper form:

- a. A Certificate of Title, which may be on the plat (signed by the owner and notarized) or in a letter form, signed by a member of the New Jersey Bar, by a title officer or authorized agent of a title insurance company licensed to do business in the State of New Jersey, which certificate shall confirm that the owner of the premises in question is the owner as shown on the plat.
 - b. Board Engineer's and Board Planner's reports.
 - c. Application for State wetlands approval, where required.
- d. Other submittals that may be required by the Board Planner, Board Engineer, Planning Board or Board of Adjustment, or by Federal, State, County or municipal law, including but not limited to a traffic report and EIS.
- e. The application for development for a minor site plan shall include a request for the granting of any variances required.
- f. Required application and escrow fees as set forth in Article 1300 of this Ordinance.
 - g. One (1) original and twenty-four (24) copies of a completed application form.
 - h. Proof of service of notice in conformance with Section 25-900.7.
- i. One (1) original and twenty-four (24) copies of a plat and attachments meeting the requirements set forth below.

25-1500.13.2 Plat Requirements.

a. General Requirements. The plan for a minor site plan shall be drawn at a scale of not less than fifty (50) feet to the inch nor larger than ten feet (10') to the inch, with

North oriented to the top of the page, on one of the four standard sheet sizes $(8.5" \times 14", 15" \times 21", 24" \times 36", 30" \times 42")$, shall conform to the provisions of the New Jersey Map Filing Law, N.J.S.A. 46:23-9.9 et seq., and shall include or be accompanied by the information specified below:

- 1. The minor site plan shall be based upon a current boundary survey prepared in accordance with N.J.A.C. 13:40-5.1, Preparation of Land Surveys, certified to the owner and prepared or recertified not more than twelve (12) months prior to the date of application. If more than 12 months has passed since the date of (or date of last recertification) of the survey, it shall be recertified and, if necessary, brought up-to-date.
- b. Title Block. A title block shall appear on all sheets and include:
 - 1. Title to read "Minor Site Plan."
 - 2. Name of development, if any.
 - 3. Tax map sheet, block and lot designation.
 - 4. Street address.
 - 5. Name of the applicant and owner.
 - 6. Date (of original and all revisions).
 - 7. Name, signature, address and license number of the professional who prepared the plan and their embossed seal.
 - 8. If the site plan contains more than one sheet, each sheet shall be numbered and titled.

c. Detailed Information.

- 1. A current aerial image (at a scale of not less than one inch (1") equals one thousand feet (1,000') with North oriented to top of the page, indicating the location of the subject parcel with reference to surrounding areas, existing streets which intersect or border the parcel, the names of all such streets and any zone district boundaries and City boundary which is within five hundred feet (500') of the subject parcel.
- 2. The names and addresses of all owners, and property classifications of all parcels within two hundred feet (200') of the subject parcel as shown by the most recent records of the City.
- 3. A portion of the current Ocean City Zoning Map showing the subject parcel and zone district boundaries, existing easements, watercourses, floodways and flood hazard areas within two hundred feet (200'), and the width of the right-of-way of each street within two hundred feet (200') of the subject parcel.
- 4. A portion of the current Ocean City Tax Map showing the subject parcel, zone district boundaries, existing easements and public rights-of-way within two hundred feet (200') of the subject parcel.
- 5. A schedule shall be placed on the site plan indicating:
 - a) The area of the tract and site (the portion of the tract involved in the site plan).

- b) The floor area (and floor area ratio where appropriate) of the existing and proposed building (listed separately).
- c) The proposed use or uses and the floor area devoted to each
- d) The zone in which the site is located.
- e) Proposed and required lot dimensions and front, rear and side setbacks.
- f) Proposed and required off-street parking spaces.
- g) Square footage and percentage of the site retained in unoccupied open space.
- h) Square footage and percentage of the site considered as Building Coverage. .
- i) Building height measured from the appropriate reference point.
- j) Applicant's compliance with the zoning requirements.
- 6. All existing structures, with an indication of those which are to be removed, and the front, rear and side yard dimensions of those to remain, referenced to existing lot lines.
- 7. All existing and proposed private and public easements or rights-of-way and the purposes thereof.
- 8. North arrow.
- 9. Written and graphic scales.
- 10. All required endorsements or certifications and space for the appropriate signatures.
- 11. A copy of any existing or proposed covenants or deed restrictions applying to the land being subdivided or certification that none exists. Such certification may be in letter form signed by a member of the New Jersey Bar, by a title officer or authorized agent of a title insurance company licensed to do business in New Jersey.
- 12. Spot elevations at all four (4) corners of the subject parcel (oceanfront parcels require two (2) additional spot elevations, one (1) at midpoint on each of the two (2) side lot lines).
- 13. Sufficient spot elevations (NAVD88 datum) and/or contour lines to indicate the proposed system of surface drainage and the relationship of proposed grading to the land surrounding the site.
- 14. FEMA flood zone, base flood elevation, Zoning Flood Elevation and such other information as may assist the Planning Board in the determination of floodway and flood hazard area limits.
- 15. The following shall also be required unless the administrative officer determines that they are not necessary to provide a full understanding of the application:
 - a) Existing at point of connection and all proposed manholes, sewer lines, waterlines, fire hydrants, utility poles and all other topographical features of a physical or engineering nature within the site and within fifty (50) feet thereof.

- b) All existing structures on the site and within fifty (50) feet thereof, including their use, thereof indicating those to be destroyed or removed and those to remain.
- c) Location, use, finished grade level, ground coverage, first floor and basement elevations, front, rear and side setbacks of all buildings and other pertinent improvements.
- d) The capacity of off-street parking areas including setbacks, location and dimensions of all access drives, aisles and parking stalls.
- e) The location, setback and size of proposed loading docks.
- f) Location of curbs, sidewalks, above-ground utilities including overhead electric transmission wires.
- g) Cross-section(s) showing the composition of pavement areas, curbs and sidewalks.
- h) Exterior lighting plan, including the location, direction of illumination, amount of illumination expressed in horizontal footcandles, wattage and drawn details of all outdoor lighting standards and fixtures.
- i) Landscaping and screening plan including planting note and plant guarantees, showing the size, location, type, spacing and number of each type of street tree, shrub and groundcover to be utilized.
- j) Location of signs and drawn details showing the size, nature of construction, height, lighting and content of all signs.
- k) Drawn details of the type of screening to be utilized for refuse storage areas, air conditioning units, outdoor equipment and bulk storage areas.
- I) Floor plans and building elevation drawings of any proposed structure or structures or existing structures to be renovated.
- m) Written description of the proposed operations in sufficient detail to indicate the effects of the use in producing traffic congestion, noise, glare, air pollution, fire hazards or safety hazards. The written description shall indicate the use, the number of shifts to be worked, the number of employees in each shift, the number of vehicles to be stored or parked on the site, and provisions to be made for site maintenance.
- n) Road dedication, where required.
- o) Proposed sight easements, where required.
- p) Proposed drainage easements, where required.
- q) Soil Erosion and Sediment Control plan, where required.
- 16. Such other information as the Board Engineer and/or Board Planner may require or request during their review of the application.

25-1500.13.3 Conditions of Approval.

Any approval of an application for development for a minor site plan granted by the Planning Board or Board of Adjustment shall be subjected to the following conditions being satisfied prior to signing of the plat or issuance of a Zoning Permit:

- a. Installation of or posting of performance guarantees for the installation of any improvements required by the Board.
 - b. Payment of any outstanding real estate taxes assessments and professional fees.
- c. Cape May County Planning Board approval if the site is located on the County road system.
 - d. New Jersey Water Company Water and sewerage service availability letters.
 - e. Granting of a CAFRA permit, where required.
- f. Submission of additional prints of the plat map and attachments for distribution (if required).
- g. Publication of a notice of the decision of the Board by the Administrative Officer (Planning Board Secretary or Board of Adjustment Secretary) within the time set forth in Section 25-900.8.
- h. Any other conditions which may be imposed by the Board or which may be required by Federal, State or municipal law.
- i. A condition setting forth the time within which all conditions must be satisfied as described in Section 25-900.10.

25-1500.13.4 Certification.

In the event that the application for development for a minor site plan is approved, a certification to that effect in the following form shall be endorsed on the plan or plat and three (3) paper copies thereof shall be provided to the Board by the applicant. Said copies shall be signed by the Chairman and Secretary of the Planning Board after they receive certification from the Administrative Officer (Planning Board or Board of Adjustment Secretary) that all conditions of approval have been satisfied. After signature, one (1) copy of the signed preliminary plat shall be returned to the applicant.

CITY OF OCEAN CITY ORDINANCE NO. 14-11 Master Plan Consistency Report

Introduction.

Ordinance 14-11 – "An ordinance amending and supplementing Chapter XXV, Zoning and Land Development of the Revised General Ordinances of the City of Ocean City (Minor Site Plan)," was introduced and adopted on first reading by City Council on March 27, 2014. According to the March 27, 2014 referral from the City Clerk, Ordinance 14-11 will be advertised according to law and is scheduled to have second reading and public hearing at the April 24, 2014 City Council meeting.

The "Municipal Land Use Law" provides the Planning Board with thirty-five (35) days from the referral date to prepare, review, adopt and transmit their consistency report regarding Ordinance 14-11 to City Council. NJS 40:55D-26 describes the Planning Board's responsibility regarding the master plan consistency review as follows:

"... the planning board shall make and transmit to the governing body, within 35 days after referral, a report including identification of any provisions in the proposed development regulation, revision or amendment which are inconsistent with the master plan and recommendations concerning those inconsistencies and any other matters as the board deems appropriate."

While formerly only zoning ordinances and amendments thereto were required to be submitted to the planning board, it is now clear from the wording in NIS 40:55D-26 that all "development regulations" must be referred to the planning board for comment and report. The statute requires that every zoning ordinance must "either be substantially consistent with the land use plan and housing plan of the master plan, or designed to effectuate such plan elements." The "Master Plan" referred to herein is the City Master Plan adopted February 3, 1988, and as subsequently amended by the Planning Board.

Ordinance Summary.

Ordinance 14-11 adds requirements for minor site plans to Article 1500 (Development Applications Procedures and Plant Details). The requirements for minor site plans established in Section 25-1500.13 include:

- Required Documents
- Plat Requirements

- > Conditions of Approval
- Certification

Minor Site Plan is defined in Section 25-107 of the City Code as follows:

A development plan of one (1) or more lots which (a) proposes exterior facade alterations and/or new building construction and/or building additions which do not exceed one thousand (1,000) square feet of gross floor area, or ten percent (10%) of the gross floor area of the existing building, whichever is greater; (b) proposes new building construction and/or building additions and/or building alterations to at least three (3) but not more than nine (9) dwelling units; (c) does not increase parking requirements of a proposed development by more than twenty (20) spaces or increase the existing parking by more than twenty percent (20%), whichever is greater; (d) does not involve planned development, any new street or the extension of any off-tract improvement; (e) contains the information reasonably required in order to make an informed determination as to whether the requirements established by ordinance for approval of a minor site plan have been met; or (f) involves a change to any use from a motel, hotel, rooming house, guest house, multi-family dwelling or other similar establishment, or (g) any change in the size, or increase or decrease in the number of rooms, units, or apartments in a motel, hotel, rooming house, guest house, multi-family dwelling, or other similar establishment; (h) any increase in the size or increase in the number of rooms, or units or apartments in a Bed and Breakfast; (i) exception to any site plan review requirement is a change in use from a Bed and Breakfast to a single-family home with no more than two (2) pre-existing and legally created ancillary and/or accessory apartments.

Findings and Conclusion.

As noted above the Planning Board's responsibility in terms of the master plan consistency review is to identify any provisions in Ordinance 14-11 which are inconsistent with the Master Plan, and make recommendations concerning those inconsistencies and any other matters as the Board deems appropriate.

In defining "substantial consistency" the Supreme Court in *Manalapan Realty v. Township Committee* made it clear that some inconsistency is permitted "provided it does not substantially or materially undermine or distort the basic provisions and objectives of the Master Plan." The "Municipal Land Use Law" does not define the term *inconsistent*.

Ordinance 14-11 will provide a much-needed mechanism to process minor site plan applications. The plat requirements contained in Section 25-1500.13.2 can be directly converted to a completeness checklist in accord with the Municipal Land Use Law. Minor site plan application and escrow fees are already in place (Chapter XXX, Schedule L).

Ordinance 14-11 advances the following objectives from the Ocean City Master Plan:

- > To encourage the coordination of regulations and activities which influence development with a goal of producing efficient uses of land with appropriate development types and scale.
- > To coordinate land use regulation and activities for improved efficiency.

I have carefully reviewed and analyzed Ordinance 14-11 and the Master Plan. Based on this review and analysis, it is my professional opinion that Ordinance 14-11 is consistent with the Ocean City Master Plan.

Re: Minor Site Plan Checklist support

Attached is the ordinance for amending and supplementing Chapter XXV, Zoning and Land Development of the Revised General Ordinances of the City of Ocean City, "Minor Site Plan" checklist to be used as the official checklist for minor site plan within the City of Ocean City. Currently we do not have one and I noticed this several years ago while consulting. The checklist needs to be officially adopted by the City as the official "Minor Site Plan Checklist". In the past, a major site plan checklist was utilized which typically required extensive waiver requests from the applicant since it is not a major site plan. There is already a fee schedule in place for minor site plans with required escrow submissions and thus not requiring any modifications.

The checklist is also supported by New Jersey Municipal Land Use Law (M.L.U.L.) as part of a submission and/or review. By adopting this, the process will be streamlined by reducing the requirements of a major site plan and waiver requests to a more sensible and applicable checklist.

ORDINANCE NO. 14-12

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER XXX (MUNICIPAL FEES) OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF OCEAN CITY, NEW JERSEY REGARDING BEACH FEE EXEMPTION FOR VETERANS (Sponsored by Councilman Allegretto, Councilman Hartzell & Councilman Wilson)

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40:61-22.20 authorizes municipalities bordering on the Atlantic Ocean, including the City of Ocean City, to charge fees as a condition of access to their beaches; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 30, Schedule D of Revised General Ordinances of the City of Ocean City, adopted pursuant to the authority granted by <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40:61-22.20, establishes beach fees for the City of Ocean City; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40:61-22.20 was amended, effective January 17, 2014, to provide that a municipality may by ordinance provide that no fees, or reduced fees, shall be charged to:

Persons who have served in any of the Armed Forces of the United States and who were discharged or released therefrom under conditions other than dishonorable and who either have served at least 90 days in active duty or have been discharged or released from active duty by reason of a service-incurred injury or disability. The Adjutant General of the New Jersey Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs shall promulgate rules and regulations pertaining to veteran eligibility under this paragraph.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Ocean City wish to recognize and honor the contributions and sacrifices made by those who have served our nation in the armed services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council, in the City of Ocean City, County of Cape May and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter 30, Schedule D of the Revised General Ordinances of the City of Ocean City is amended and supplemented to provide as follows:

SCHEDULE D BEACH FEES

9. Veterans

- (a) No fees shall be charged to or collected from persons who have served in any of the Armed Forces of the United States and who were discharged or released therefrom under conditions other than dishonorable and who either have served at least 90 days in active duty or have been discharged or released from active duty by reason of a service-incurred injury or disability.
- (b) The Director of Financial Management shall maintain a list of all individuals to whom beach tags are issued pursuant to subsection 9(a) above, including the names of all individuals who qualify for the beach fee exemption. The Director of Financial Management shall also establish procedures pursuant to the rules and regulations promulgated by the Adjutant General of the New Jersey Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs pertaining to veteran eligibility for this beach fee exemption.
- (c) Beach tags issued under this subsection 9 shall be available at City Hall whenever beach tags are sold, and at such other locations as the Mayor shall deem advisable.

SECTION 3: REPEALER: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict only.

<u>SECTION 4: SEVERABILITY:</u> If any section, paragraph, subdivision, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, subsection, clause or provision declared invalid and the remainder of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect and shall be enforceable.

SECTION 5: **EFFECTIVE DATE**: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final adoption and publication and in the manner prescribed by law.

As you may recall at the February 27, 2014 City Council meeting, a contract was awarded to All Surface Asphalt Paving, Inc. for improvements to the 15th Street playground. At that time adequate funding was available to only award the base bid for the project. Since that date a new capital funding bond ordinance has been passed and additional funding is now available. The additional funding will allow for the resurfacing of the large basketball court as well as the installation of new backboards for the court. In addition, benches and trash cans will now be installed. Both of these items were alternate bid items on the original bid and All Surface Asphalt Paving was the low bidder for each of these alternate bid items as well as the project as a whole.

This project includes the refurbishing of the existing playground equipment as well as the addition of some new play equipment. Also included in the project are the installation of 2 shades and new play surface at 15th Street playground. The play surface is proposed to be similar in fashion to the surfaces at North Street and 34th Street playgrounds. Benches and trash receptacles will be installed to provide additional seating as well as a consistent look for all of our playgrounds. Also included is the replacement of the small and large basketball court and backstops, grading and drainage improvements as well as irrigation and landscaping improvements to the site. Also included in the total improvements for the playground is the installation of a bathroom building similar in style to the 11th Street boardwalk bathroom. This building was previously purchased and will be installed prior to the 2014 summer.

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE A WAIVER OF THE CITY'S RIGHT TO HAVE AN EASEMENT INTEREST IN CERTAIN BEACH LOTS APPRAISED AND WAIVING ITS RIGHT TO JUST COMPENSATION FOR GIVING TO THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY AN EASEMENT IN SAID LOTS FOR FLOOD HAZARD RISK REDUCTION MEASURES.

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection ("NJDEP") requested the City of Ocean City to execute a Deed of Dedication and Perpetual Storm Damage Reduction Easement ("the Deed") in consideration for the benefits to be received by the City of Ocean City from the successful implementation of a project to be undertaken by the City, the NJDEP and the United States Army Corps of Engineers known as the Great Egg Harbor Inlet to Townsends Inlet, New Jersey Project, as defined in the October 24, 2006 Chief's Report issued by the Department of the Army ("the Project"); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Ordinance No. 13-34, Ocean City voluntarily executed the Deed, as requested, and had the Deed recorded in the Office of the Clerk of Cape May County on December 5, 2013 in Deed Book 3562, Page 201, #227; and

WHEREAS, City Council recognizes, and welcomes, the benefits to be received by the City from the Project and, further, recognizes that the easement interest in the City-owned properties subject to the Deed have nominal or no development value as the properties in the Project area are located in the City's Beach and Dune Zone, are located on the oceanward side of the bulkhead line and are all either beach or dunes or a combination of beach and dune; and

WHEREAS, City Council further recognizes and understands that the City is entitled to have an appraisal prepared for purposes of determining the amount of just compensation due to the City for the value of the property interest transferred by the Deed; and

WHEREAS, City Council has concluded that there is no practical reason to have the said property interest appraised, and desires to release the NJDEP Office of Flood Hazard Risk Reduction Measures from the obligation to obtain an appraisal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Ocean City that the Mayor of Ocean City or his designee be and the same is hereby authorized to execute the attached Intention to Donate and Release of Obligation to Provide an Appraisal.
