

ORDINANCE NO. 15-15

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND FIXING SALARY FOR
DIRECTOR OF FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT, DIRECTOR OF POLICE SERVICES
AND DIRECTOR OF FIRE & RESCUE SERVICES**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Ocean City, County of Cape May, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1.

Salary increases will be implemented in accordance with the following for each listed title:

Effective January 1, 2015

Director of Financial Management	1.5% increase to base salary
Director of Police Services	1.5% increase to base salary
Director of Fire and Rescue Services	1.5% increase to base salary

Effective January 1, 2016

Director of Financial Management	1.25 % increase to base salary
Director of Police Services	1.25 % increase to base salary
Director of Fire and Rescue Services	1.25% increase to base salary

Effective January 1, 2017

Director of Financial Management	1.25 % increase to base salary
Director of Police Services	1.25 % increase to base salary
Director of Fire and Rescue Services	1.25% increase to base salary

Effective January 1, 2018

Director of Financial Management	1.25 % increase to base salary
Director of Police Services	1.25 % increase to base salary
Director of Fire and Rescue Services	1.25% increase to base salary

SECTION 2.

Said salary increases are contingent upon the availability of funds.

SECTION 3.

Any person hereafter appointed to a position of employment with the City of Ocean City shall be appointed pursuant to the Ocean City Administrative Code, §2-1.22.

SECTION 4.

All ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent with this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 5.

If any portion of this Ordinance is declared to be invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect the remaining portions of the Ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6.

This Ordinance shall take effect in the time and manner prescribed by law.

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND FIXING SALARY FOR

SECTION 1.

Effective January 1, 2015	1.5% increase to base salary
Effective January 1, 2016	1.25 % increase to base salary
Effective January 1, 2017	1.25 % increase to base salary
Effective January 1, 2018	1.25 % increase to base salary

SECTION 2.

Said salary increases are contingent upon the availability of funds.

SECTION 3.

Any person hereafter appointed to a position of employment with the City of Ocean City shall be appointed pursuant to the Ocean City Administrative Code, §2-1.16a.
