### DESIGNATING THE SKATE PARK AS AN UNSUPERVISED FACILITY AND ESTABLISHING THE ASSOCIATED RULES FOR THE PARK

WHEREAS, the City of Ocean City is currently constructing a skate park within the 500 block of Asbury Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the skate park is expected to be completed and opened later this year; and

WHEREAS, the Atlantic County Municipal Joint Insurance Fund requires its members to determine by resolution of the governing body whether skate parks are supervised or unsupervised; and

WHEREAS, rules for operation and use of the skate park are also to be established by resolution.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of Ocean City, NJ that the skate park will be operated as an UNSUPERVISED facility; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following rules are established and will be posted on appropriate signage at the skate park:

- 1. Skate Park will be open daily from 9:00 am to dusk (weather permitting).
- 2. Skate Park will be closed during inclement weather and/or when equipment is damaged or wet or for routine maintenance.
- 3. The following protective equipment is required to be used while skating: helmet, elbow pads, knee pads.
- 4. Use of personally owned ramps, boxes, rails or other similar items is prohibited.
- 5. Use of alcohol and tobacco products is prohibited.
- 6. Skate Park is for skating only. Bikes and scooters are prohibited.
- 7. No amplified sound is permitted except by permit.
- 8. Parental supervision for inexperienced skaters and those less than 12 years of age is strongly recommended.
- 9. No food or glass containers are permitted in the skate park.
- 10. Unsafe conditions should be reported to the City of Ocean City, Department of Community Services.
- 11. Skating is prohibited on the adjacent parking lots, sidewalks and streets.
- 12. Proper behavior is required at all times. Abusive, profane language or aggressive behavior will not be tolerated.
- 13. Rules violations will result in suspension of skating privileges.

JIF/MEL guidelines for skate parks require the governing body to determine by resolution if the facility will be supervised or unsupervised. In this regard "supervised" means there is an attendant during all open hours actively monitoring the use of the park. "Unsupervised" does not mean that the park will be completely unmonitored. To the contrary, the park and its users will be checked frequently by members of the Police Department, Community Services Department and others.

This resolution designates the Skate Park as "Unsupervised" and establishes appropriate rules.



### Dear Mayor Gillian:

Thank you for the opportunity to meet with you last week. Clearly there is a present need to reestablish navigable waters as soon as possible and to develop a long term strategy to fund, plan, permit, and manage a City dredging program including public outreach meetings. ACT Engineers, in association with Anchor QEA, LLC, is pleased to submit this proposal for consideration, to provide initial planning services to formulate an effective dredging program for Ocean City. This initial phase will permit the ACT/Anchor team to review historical dredge records, regulatory correspondence, and conduct a reconnaissance site visit of the priority dredge areas as well as the currently available CDF at Route 52 and CDF 83. This document review and understanding will facilitate us providing a realistic proposal for the short term execution and long term management of the dredging and shoreline program.

A significant number of strategies have been considered by the City. Out of necessity to take action, measures to address some aspects of a near term dredging project are underway. It is our understanding that these measures include: removal of up to 50,000 cubic yards of material from CDF 83; on-going permitting for a temporary access roadway to CDF 83; on-going permitting for modification of the CDF under Route 52; and draft shoreline restoration plan funded by a USFWS grant.

The ACT Team has the knowledge needed to execute a dredging operation and to plan, design, and implement a sustainable dredging program through the development of a long term Dredging Master Plan for Ocean City. ACT proposes the following staff for this project.

In order to reduce cost and avoid duplication of effort, the ACT Team can be of best benefit and least cost to the City by providing initial services over the next few weeks as follows:

- Permitting documents (submitted to-date, and from most recent past project)
- Regulatory correspondence in recent years
- Recent bid information (cost sheets and estimates, etc.)
- Conduct initial site visits

### Tasks 2 & 3 Fall 2015 and 2016 Dredging Program Support

Based on the results of our review, we will scope out Phase 2 (Fall 2015 dredging program). It is envisioned at this stage that the program will involve the following elements:

- Bathymetric survey of the two dredge areas
- Topographic survey of site 83 and dikes
- Reconnaissance survey of the docks at the dredge areas
- Sediment sampling of the dredge areas
- Dredge prism development and volume calculations
- Transport and Placement into Site 83
- Bid documents (plans, specs and cost estimate)
- Public education and stake holder (agency) meetings
- Bid support and contractor selection, and
- Construction management and inspection.
