## CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES THURSDAY, DECEMBER 12, 2019 – 7:00 PM CITY HALL COUNCIL CHAMBERS

ATTENDANCE: Mr. Barr, Ms. Bergman (absent), Mr. DeVlieger, Mr. Hartzell Mr. McClellan, Mr. Wilson and Mr. Madden. Present also was Mayor Gillian, Business Administrator, Mr. Savastano and Solicitor, Ms. McCrosson.

Council President Mr. Madden called the meeting to order and asked everyone to rise for the flag salute and prayer. Mr. Madden announced that adequate notice of this meeting has been given pursuant to Public Law 1975, Chapter 231.

#### PROCLAMATION:

The Mayor and Council presented a proclamation to the Ocean City High School Varsity Girls Soccer Team.

## CITIZEN COMMENT:

Ric Bertsch - 117 Bark Drive - spoke about Ordinance No. 19-14 and storm water management.

<u>Donna Moore – 21 Ocean Ave</u> – spoke about public lands being eco-friendly and the harmful effects of the use of pesticides on the island.

<u>Bill Hartranft – 728 Battersea Road</u> – spoke about organic treatment of soil which he thinks is a good idea and he also thanked administration and council for the update on the Klaus properties. He spoke about Ordinance No. 19-14 and said he is not in favor of more concrete on the island.

<u>Nelson – Clarke, house of dice – 12<sup>th</sup> & Central Ave</u> – spoke about the Ocean City Police Department and St. Peter's Methodist Church. He also spoke about the oaths of office for the City Clerk, Mayor and Solicitor as well as City Council.

<u>Steve Bassett - 7 Osborne Road, Somers Point</u> - said that Mr. Dice deserves to be an attending member of St. Peter's Methodist Church and asked the Mayor to make a phone call in an effort to give Mr. Dice a fair hearing with the Judge.

<u>Chuck Deal – 2837 Central Ave</u> – spoke about Ordinance No. 19-14 and suggested natural landscapes like Phoenix, LBI and California; they use sand and stone.

#### APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Mr. Madden asked for a motion to adopt the regular city council meeting minutes of Tuesday, November 26, 2019. Motion made by Mr. Barr, seconded by Mr. Wilson. All were in favor with the exception of Mr. Hartzell who abstained.

## REPORTS - MAYOR & ADMINISTRATION:

Solicitor, Ms. McCrosson provided and update on the status of the Klaus properties. The city is currently in negotiations and will acquire the land through negotiations or condemnation if necessary. The city plans to preserve the land as open space with some parking. The Mayor will have a town hall meeting to solicit ideas from the public to discuss ways to configure the space.

Business Administrator, Mr. Savastano provided and update on the beach replenishment program and he also answered questions inquired by Ms. Moore regarding the payment of claims and organic land management contracts.

# ORDINANCE: SECOND READING & PUBLIC HEARING:

Mr. Madden asked for a motion to take up Ordinance No. 19-14 on second reading and public hearing. Motion moved by Mr. Barr, seconded by Mr. Wilson. All ayes followed. The clerk read the ordinance by title. Ordinance No. 19-14 – An Ordinance Amending and Supplementing Chapter XXV, Zoning and Land Development of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Ocean City – Driveways, Parking, Grass Block Pavers

Solicitor, Ms. McCrosson provided an explanation on the ordinance. Mr. Madden opened the meeting up for public comment on Ordinance No. 19-14.

<u>Chuck Deal</u> – spoke about section 6 and asked that the footnote in section 6 be eliminated from the ordinance. <u>Mary Alice</u> – said that she is concerned about the density and parking.

<u>Donna Moore</u> – spoke about the grass block pavers and permeability. She said section 3 should not be delet4ed in its entirety; she suggested part "J" of section 3 be eliminated.

After some discussion between the governing body regarding section 3 of the ordinance as well the footnotes it was suggested that the Ordinance be tabled until January. Mr. Madden asked for a motion to table Ordinance No. 19-14. Motion moved by Mr. Barr, seconded by Mr. Hartzell. All ayes followed.

The clerk read the ordinance by title.
