<u>HPC14-007</u> – 617 – 8th Street Blk: 705 Lot: 17 – Demolition A motion to accept the resolution was made by Jeff Frost and a second motion was made by Susan Matthews. All were in favor.

<u>HPC15-001</u> – 708 Wesley Avenue Blk: 706 Lot 11 – Garage Demolition A motion to accept the resolution was made by John Loeper and a second motion was made by Jeff Frost. All were in favor.

John Loeper spoke about a revision that he believes needs to be inserted into the proposed revised Historic District ordinance. Under 25-1800.2.25 – State and National Districts are not mentioned only Local. Jack Ball will speak with Ms. McCrosson and have her respond. The commission agrees someone from the State should review the proposed changes to the Historic District ordinance.

John Loeper informed the members of the commission on an upcoming seminar being held on Saturday, March 28th for anyone who may be interested in attending. The course provides an in-depth examination of current topics and issues relevant to integrating preservation into community planning and zoning.
