Michele Gillian announced that Ocean City has been named Best Beach in America by Coastal Living Magazine. Coastal Living will be coming to Ocean City to do an article on the Best Beach in America. This will be featured in the June edition of Coastal Living magazine. She thanked everyone for voting to make this a reality.

NEW BUSINESS: There is billboard space available on the Walt Whitman Bridge beginning May 9th for seven weeks for \$14,000. There is a temporary hold on this board in case the Tourism Commission would like to advertise Best Beach In America. The members of the Tourism Commission agreed that the secretary should prepare a resolution for the May 12th Tourism meeting authorizing payment for this board.

James Mallon recently met with representatives from Comcast Spotlight on Geo Fencing to capture ad placement on all mobile devices per a specific geographic location. Ocean City will be the test market. May will be the test to deliver this. An impression is guaranteed delivery of someone actually viewing the ad on a mobile device. Total investment for 150,000 impressions is \$5,100. The City will be working with Comcast Spotlight on this project.
