An application by The Town of Georgetown, for an official zoning map amendment from Neighborhood Business (UB2) to Limited Industrial (LI-1) for the property located at 413 South Bedford Street, Georgetown, DE identified as Sussex County Tax District 135 Map 20.00 Parcel 50.00.
