Any qualified candidate interested in filing for these offices may do so at the Town Hall.

*Due to Friday, April 18, 2014 being Good Friday, and Town Offices are Closed  
The new filing deadline is Thursday, April 17, 2014 at 5:00 p.m.*

### **Guidelines for Candidates:**

1. The Mayor shall be twenty-one (21) years of age, a citizen of the United States, the State of Delaware, and a bona fide resident of the Town of Georgetown.
2. The Town Council Person from the Third Ward shall be twenty-one (21) years of age, a citizen of the United States, the State of Delaware, a bona fide resident of the Town of Georgetown, and a bona fide resident of the Third Ward.
3. The Town Council Person from the Fourth Ward shall be twenty-one (21) years of age, a citizen of the United States, the State of Delaware, a bona fide resident of the Town of Georgetown, and a bona fide resident of the Fourth Ward.

### **Terms of Office:**

Town Council terms of office shall be for a period of two (2) years.

### **Voter Registration:**

**Voter Registration deadline for the 2014 Municipal Election is  
Friday, April 25, 2014 at 4:30 PM**

**You must be a registered voter in the Town of Georgetown.**

It is still necessary to register with the Town of Georgetown, even if you are a registered voter with the State of Delaware.

At such Annual Municipal Election, every person, male or female, who shall have attained the age of eighteen (18) years on the date of the Annual Municipal Election and who shall be a bona fide resident of the Town of Georgetown shall have one (1) vote, provided he or she is registered on the "Books of Registered Voters" of the Town of Georgetown.

### **Absentee Voting**

Any registered voter of the Town of Georgetown, who wishes to vote by absentee voting, may do so by obtaining an "Affidavit for Absentee Voting" at the Town Hall. Absentee ballots will be available Monday, April 21, 2014. Absentee ballots can either be picked up at Town Hall or mailed. The deadline for voting by absentee ballot in person is Friday, May 9, 2014 at 12:00pm.
