POST OFFICE Circa 1889

Welcome to the Coastal Towns Historic Village in Ocean View, Delaware!

The first free standing Ocean View Post Office was built in 1889 when Ocean View became incorporated as a town, thus qualifying for its own Post Office. The postal office was a source of income for its Postmistress, Annie West Betts, whose husband drowned in a shipwreck. For supplemental income, Annie operated a millinery (hat) shop in the rear of the Post Office. Annie was the daughter of politically connected George West, who owned the blue Tunnell-West house next door.

The Ocean View Post Office was donated to the Coastal Towns Historic Village by Shirley Reed, a member of the West family.
