1. CALL TO ORDER

2. ADOPTION OF AGENDA

A motion was made by Council Member Bodine, seconded by Council Member Maly, to adopt the agenda. The motion carried unanimously 4/0.

3. SWEARING IN OF COUNCIL MEMBERS

William A. Olsen and Frank G. Twardzik were sworn-in by Town Solicitor Dennis Schrader.
